Pastor Report for 2024 Annual Conference, November 3

As I sit to write this report, I am in awe of all you have done in 2024. What an amazing year it has been! I am reflecting on Baby Grace, Parkwood Heights Day School, Worship, Small Groups, Kingdom Kids, Missions, Good Faith Network and so much more. You have truly been the light of Christ to the community and continue to thrive in your ministry and faith. In the fall of 2024, IHUMC held their "Transmitting the Light" stewardship campaign. The focus was on the stained glass in the sanctuary that walks through the story of God's people. Each week focused on a different window and the scripture that inspired it. While the theme scripture was from the Gospel of Matthew.

IHUMC has served families every month through Baby Grace. As a church, you saw the need for diapers in our community and continue to fulfill that need even with the pot seems empty. You all show up, buy the diapers, wrap the diapers and hand them out every month. An average of 50 families a month receive diapers and relationships have begun to form with each of them.

The light has shine through the partnership being built with Parkwood Heights Day School. In 2023, IHUMC voted to sell the parsonage and partner with Parkwood Heights. This partnership has shown to be fruitful in so many ways. The children that fill the halls during the week have brought life and light to the once quite halls. Christ shines in each of their small faces, on the smiles of the teachers and every IHUMC member that they meet. IHUMC has a long history of children's ministry, and this partnership with Parkwood continues to show the importance of providing children with a safe, nurturing and welcoming place to learn and grow their faith. Missions continue to be a focus at IHUMC. Baby Grace has become a main focus yet out of Baby Grace a food pantry has grown. A once small food cabinet now provides food to the community twice a week and on the first Saturday of the month. Those who need food are invited to come to the pantry, without questions, and get what they need. This openness makes individuals feel comfortable and worthy when they often are shamed for needing help. The light shining in the volunteers is shown through their warm welcome, hospitality and true care for people. IHUMC continues to volunteer and serve with IHN, Westridge Middle School and advocate for justice in our community with the Good Faith Network. Mercy and justice are important to the people of Indian Heights, and this shows every time you all show up and serve without question, with kindness and Christ shining through all you do.

By being the church on the hill with the light that never goes out, IHUMC has grown in the last year. More children are attending Kingdom kids, a youth group has begun with an average of 3-4 kids/week, membership continues to go up and new visitors continue to walk through the door's week after week.




Weather Alert:
